Pasadena has played host to some of the world’s most noted sporting events including Super Bowls, Men’s World Cup and the U.S. National Diving Championships. Our storied history and first-rate facilities make the city a natural choice for indoor and outdoor sporting events of all sizes.

Fact: Major League Baseball legend Jackie Robinson resided in Pasadena from 1922 – 1946.

ROSE BOWL STADIUM

The Rose Bowl Stadium has earned its world-famous reputation by hosting the 1984 Olympic soccer matches, 1999 Women’s World Cup, five NFL Super Bowls, three BCS college football National Championship Games, concerts, and more.

- Built in 1922, the Rose Bowl seats 90,000+.
- The stadium is currently home to UCLA Bruins football, the annual Rose Bowl Game and the world’s largest flea market.
- The turf area inside the bowl measures 79,156 square feet.
- The dimensions of the playing field for football are 53 yards (w) x 100 yards (l).
- The dimensions of the playing field for soccer are 70 yards (w) x 120 yards (l).
- Ample locker room facilities and a press box are offered.

PASADENA CITY COLLEGE

In 1999, Pasadena City College opened its campus athletic complex.

Robinson Stadium

- The stadium seats 5,400.
- The field is designed for football and soccer.
- The stadium also features an all-weather track.

Aquatic Center

- The 50-meter pool is designed for water polo and swimming.
- Bleachers are available for spectator viewing.

Hutto-Patterson Gymnasium

- The gym offers a regulation basketball court.
- Badminton, volleyball, wrestling, fencing and other sports can be played here.
- Seating is available for 2,500.

AAF ROSE BOWL AQUATICS CENTER

The Amateur Athletic Foundation Rose Bowl Aquatics Center is a world-class swimming and diving facility located just south of the Rose Bowl Stadium.

- The facility offers two 50-meter pools with depths up to 17 feet.
- Amenities include two hydro spas and an exercise room.
- Locker rooms and showers are housed in the clubhouse.
- The pools hosted the U.S. National Diving Championships in 2008.
- The center served as the practice site for the 2000 U.S. Olympic swim team.

BROOKSIDE GOLF CLUB

Designed by famed golf architect William P. Bell, Brookside Golf Club is nestled in the foothills directly adjacent to the Rose Bowl Stadium.

- Choose from two championship 18-hole courses.
- Practice with putting greens and a driving range.
- A clubhouse, restaurant and golf shop complete the package.
- Major championships played here include the Los Angeles Open and the National Public Links Championship.

EATON CANYON GOLF COURSE

Located in the hills above Pasadena, Eaton Canyon Golf Course was designed by William P. Bell Jr.

- The course features a regulation nine-hole layout.
- Amenities include a clubhouse, golf shop and restaurant.
- Putting greens and a driving range are available.
- 1961 PGA Champion Jerry Barber attended the course's opening in 1962.

ARROYO SECO

This lush 132-acre recreational area is home to the Rose Bowl Stadium, Brookside Golf Club, Rose Bowl Aquatics Center and Brookside Park.

- Hiking trails can be found throughout the Lower Arroyo.
- Bicyclists can circle the 3.3-mile loop around the Rose Bowl Stadium.
- Facilities are offered for archery and casting.
